The following pages may be reproduced and cut in half to make rhythm cards. To make the exact number of cards to match the poem, make the following copies:

Quarter Notes = 2 copies (4 cards)
Eighth Notes $=5$ copies ( 9 cards with 1 extra)
Eighth/Sixteenth Notes = 1 copy ( 2 cards)
Sixteenth/Eighth Notes = 1 copy ( 1 card with 1 extra)
Sixteenth Notes = not needed for the poem, can be used with extension activities
If possible, use different colors of paper, one for each note value, to help students tell them apart.

You may experiment with making lots of extra copies so there are lots of choices or only the exact cards to match the poem.
